

CHAMPAGNE

Bruno Paillard Premiere Cuvee Brut £39.95
(NV) France
Chardonnay and Pinot Noir combine to produce a wine with fine beads of bubbles and a palate showing fresh citrus flavours and more rounded berry fruits.

Lanson Black Label Brut £45.00
(NV) France
Chardonnay, Pinot Noir & Pinot Meunier. Toasty characteristics combine with a variety of flowers and honey creating a sensation of plenitude and lightness.

Bollinger Special Cuvee £58.00
(NV) France
This is one of the most complex Champagnes with developed fruit characters and biscuity, brioche tones.

SPARKLING WINE

Thomas Mitchell Brut £23.00
(NV) Australia
The aroma has lifted character of meringue and delicate white flowers. The palate is soft and mouth-filling with a generous explosion of bubbles.

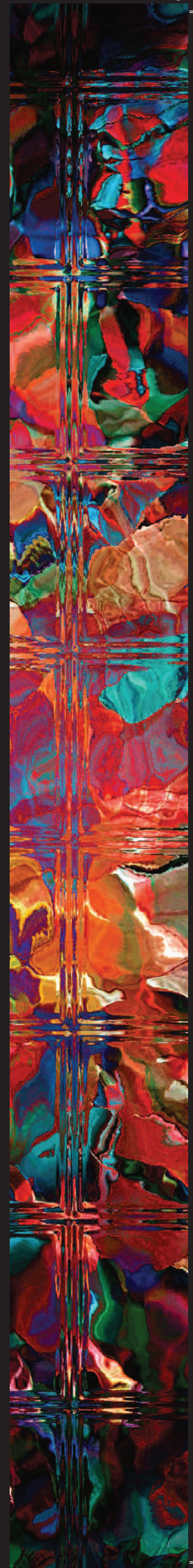
Prosecco di Valdobbiadene Brut Jeio £26.50
(NV) Italy
The Jeio shows a brilliant straw yellow colour and an extremely fine and vivacious mousse. The fruitiness of the wine emerges in a pleasing and elegant fashion.

SPARKLING ROSÉ

Graham Beck Brut Rosé £31.00
(NV) South Africa
The palate explodes with raspberry fruit together with sherbety apples and biscuit notes on the finish.

Lanson Rosé Brut £47.00
(NV) France
Chardonnay, Pinot Noir & Pinot Meunier. Aromas of roses and fruit predominate, with discrete notes of red fruit. Rounded and fresh, this wine has a harmonious balance.

WHITES WINES

Casa de Piedra Chardonnay £16.95

(2006/07) Chile

A delicious nose of melon and grapefruit with a touch of creamy oak. On the palate the wine is ripe and fruity, with a refreshing acidity.

San Rafael Sauvignon Blanc £18.50

(2007/08) Chile

Cool, crisp and fruity with soft tropical fruit notes of pineapple and passion fruit.

Acacia Tree Chenin Blanc-Colombard £17.95

(2007/08) South Africa

Fresh citrus and peach flavours with zippy acidity and a refreshing finish.

Argento Pinot Grigio £20.50

(2007/08) Argentina

A fresh and fruity Pinot Grigio with juicy apple, pear and peach notes cut through by crisp lemony acidity.

SAAM Mountain Chenin Blanc £23.00

(2007/08) South Africa

A tropical nose consisting of pear, guava and ripe yellow stone fruit. The abundance of flavours carries through to a mouth filling palate and stays there!

Poacher's Blend, St Hallett £22.00

(Semillon/Sauvignon/Riesling)

(2007/08) Australia

Brimming full of tropical fruit flavours, passion fruit, melon and pineapple with underlying lime and grassy aromas, as well as citrus hints from the Riesling.

Oveja Negra Pinot Grigio/Riesling £21.00

(2006/07) Brazil

A fruity aroma with traces of white fruits and kernels. The mouth feel shows a balanced structure, with a gorgeous aftertaste.

Preece Chardonnay £25.00

(2006/07) Australia

Intense peach, nectarine and lime flavours complemented by a touch of vanilla and coconut.

Spy Valley Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc £27.00

(2006/07) New Zealand

Classic characters of gooseberry and asparagus, with ripe melon. Really delicately balanced and at the same time deliciously quaffable.

Chablis, Michel Laroche £33.00

(2006/07) France

Deliciously dry, with steely, mineral notes and a long, lingering and very smart finish.

ROSÉ

Deakin Estate Cabernet Merlot Rosé £19.95

(2006/07) Australia

A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, lush and creamy in texture, with abundant red berry flavour and a lively, crisp finish.

RED WINES

Casa de Piedra Cabernet Sauvignon £16.95

(2005/06) Chile

A powerful nose of red and black fruits, with a hint of dark chocolate. The palate is full-bodied, deliciously ripe and packed with fruit.

San Rafael Merlot £18.50

(2006/07) Chile

Soft, smooth, easy-drinking wine with juicy, plummy Merlot fruit on the nose. The palate is fruity and jammy with crowd-pleasing red berry and cherry fruit.

Oveja Negra Tempranillo/Touriga £19.50

(2007/08) Brazil

Very soft in the mouth with berry flavours such as cherry, blackberry, tobacco and cassis. A well-structured, medium bodied wine.

Gamekeeper's Reserve, St Hallett £22.00

(Shiraz/Grenache/Mourvedre)

(2006/07) Australia

Floral and aromatic on the nose. Juicy fruit and savoury spice on the palate with a cherry, raspberry, bramble jelly and black pepper to the fore.

Thesaurum Corvina/Cabernet Sauvignon £21.00

(2005/06) Italy

Perfumed, almost floral nose with cherries, violets and cassis. The palate is fresh and bright with deep black olive and blackberry flavours and subtle peppery spice.

Castillo di Clavijo Rioja Crianza £24.00

(2003/04) Spain

Good intense aromas of ripe red fruits, spices and vanilla are carried through to a well balanced palate, with cherries and other berry fruits. Elegant and harmonious.

Argento Reserva Malbec £20.50

(2006/07) Argentina

An exceptional wine offering dark violet colours and explosive aromatics. Full rich concentrated fruit flavours and soft tannins.

Knapstein Cabernet/Merlot £28.00

(2005/06) Australia

Generous lifted blackberry and cassis with hints of eucalyptus on the nose lead to a palate of rich generous blackcurrents and red berry fruits. The wine also has the added complexity of ripe fine tannins giving it a lovely soft velvety texture.

Deakin Estate Shiraz £23.50

(2005/06) Australia

Bold, raspberry-charged Shiraz with punnets of fruit with the power to stand up to spicy dishes.

SAAM Mountain Leeuwenkuil Pinotage £27.00

(2006/07) South Africa

Ripe berry fruit with cassis. Fresh acidity with powerful intensity, layers of fruit, chocolate and spice, balanced ripe tannins with a long lingering finish.
